WHEREAS, a Special Municipal Election was ordered to be held in the City of Los Angeles pursuant to Ordinance No. 185641 to place a measure before the voters and the election was consolidated with the State of California General Election held November 6, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the following Measure was submitted to a vote of the qualified voters of the City of Los Angeles:

**REALIGN CITY AND STATE ELECTION DATES. CHARTER AMENDMENT E**

Shall the City Charter be amended to realign the City's primary election date with the State's primary election held in March of even-numbered years, and make other related and technical changes to City election procedures?

WHEREAS, the County of Los Angeles Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk did canvass the returns of the Special Municipal Election held in the City of Los Angeles on November 6, 2018, and certified them to the City Council; and

WHEREAS, it appears to the Los Angeles City Council that the canvass of votes is true and correct.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Los Angeles City Council hereby finds, determines, and declares that the total number of votes cast for and against City of Los Angeles Charter Amendment E at the Special Municipal Election by the qualified voters was 975,474, as set forth in the certification of the Los Angeles City Clerk and that the measure, as proposed by Resolution of the Los Angeles City Council, is hereby declared to have been approved by a majority of the voters voting thereon.

WHEREAS, the following Measure was submitted to a vote of the qualified voters of the Los Angeles Unified School District:

**REALIGN LOS ANGELES UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT (LAUSD) AND STATE ELECTION DATES. CHARTER AMENDMENT EE**

Shall the City Charter be amended to realign the LAUSD Board of Education's primary election date with the State's primary election held in March of even-numbered years, and make other related and technical changes to LAUSD election procedures?

WHEREAS, the County of Los Angeles Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk did canvass the returns of the Special Municipal Election held in the Los Angeles Unified School District on November 6, 2018, and certified them to the City Council; and

WHEREAS, it appears to the Los Angeles City Council that the canvass of votes is true and correct.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Los Angeles City Council hereby finds, determines, and declares that the total number of votes cast for and against Charter Amendment EE at the Special Municipal Election by the qualified voters was 1,153,268, as set forth in the certification of the Los Angeles City Clerk and that the measure, as proposed by Resolution of the Los Angeles City Council, is hereby declared to have been approved by a majority of the voters voting thereon.
