

RULES, ELECTIONS, AND INTERGOVERNMENTAL RELATIONS COMMITTEE REPORT and RESOLUTION relative to establishing the City's position regarding California Assembly Bill (AB) 220, which would amend the Political Reform Act of 1974 to expressly allow campaign funds to be used for child care.

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Resolution (Martinez - Rodriguez - Ryu), SUBJECT TO THE CONCURRENCE OF THE MAYOR:

ADOPT the accompanying RESOLUTION to include in the City's 2019-20 State Legislative Program, SUPPORT for AB 220 which would amend the Political Reform Act of 1974 to expressly allow campaign funds to be used for child care by those who choose to run for elected offices in California.

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the Chief Legislative Analyst. The City Administrative Officer has not completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

At a special meeting held on February 15, 2019, the Rules, Elections, and Intergovernmental Relations Committee considered Resolution (Martinez - Rodriguez - Ryu) and CLA report relative to establishing the City's position to support AB 220, which would amend the Political Reform Act of 1974 to expressly allow campaign funds to be used for child care.

After providing an opportunity for public comment, the Committee recommended that Council adopt the accompanying Resolution. This matter is now forwarded to Council for its consideration.
