

RULES, ELECTIONS, AND INTERGOVERNMENTAL RELATIONS COMMITTEE REPORT and RESOLUTION relative to establishing the City's position regarding legislation and/or administrative action aimed at exploring accommodations to balance the preservation of equine keeping with the location of Accessory Dwelling Units (ADUs).

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Resolution (Rodriguez - Blumenfield - Lee - O'Farrell - Ryu), SUBJECT TO THE CONCURRENCE OF THE MAYOR:

ADOPT the accompanying RESOLUTION to include in the City's 2019-20 State Legislative Program:

- a. SUPPORT for and/or SPONSORSHIP of legislation and/or administrative action aimed at exploring accommodations to balance the preservation of equine keeping with the location of ADUs by amending California Government Code Section 65852.2(a)(1)(D)(vii) and e(1)(B).
- b. INSTRUCT the appropriate City departments to include equine considerations when State-wide land use policies are being considered in the future, consult with equine keeping experts, or create a focus group comprised of jurisdictions with equine keeping zones, when land use deliberations are taking place.
