

RULES, ELECTIONS, AND INTERGOVERNMENTAL RELATIONS COMMITTEE REPORT and RESOLUTION relative to establishing the City's position regarding the State's budget proposal to invest in pilot projects with First 5 California, First 5 Commissioners, and local government.

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Resolution (Ryu - Wesson – et al.), SUBJECT TO THE CONCURRENCE OF THE MAYOR:

ADOPT the accompanying RESOLUTION to include in the City's 2019-20 State Legislative Program, SUPPORT for the Governor's Fiscal Year 2019-20 Budget proposal to provide a one-time General Fund investment of \$50 million to support and implement pilot projects and partnerships with First 5 California, local First 5 Commissioners, local government, and philanthropy to increase access to Children's Savings Account programs among incoming kindergartners.

#### SUMMARY
