

RULES, ELECTIONS, AND INTERGOVERNMENTAL RELATIONS COMMITTEE REPORT and RESOLUTION relative to establishing the City's position regarding support for and funding of After School Education and Safety (ASES) Programs.

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Resolution (Ryu - Wesson - et al.), SUBJECT TO THE CONCURRENCE OF THE MAYOR:

ADOPT the accompanying RESOLUTION to include in the City's 2019-20 State Legislative Program, SUPPORT for legislation that would continuously appropriate an additional \$112,800,000 from the General Fund to the State Department of Education for ASES Programs.
