

RULES, ELECTIONS, AND INTERGOVERNMENTAL RELATIONS COMMITTEE REPORT and RESOLUTIONS relative to legislation to adopt a State Historic Rehabilitation Tax Credit, and to amend the State Government Code to allow homeless shelters on private land during declared emergencies.

Recommendation for Council action, SUBJECT TO THE CONCURRENCE OF THE MAYOR:

ADOPT the accompanying RESOLUTIONS to include in the City's 2019-20 State Legislative Program, SUPPORT or SPONSORSHIP of legislation to adopt a State Historic Rehabilitation Tax Credit, and to amend the State Government Code to allow homeless shelters on private land during declared emergencies.

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the Chief Legislative Analyst. The City Administrative Officer has not completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

At a special meeting held on November 16, 2018, the Rules, Elections and Intergovernmental Relations Committee considered a CLA report and Resolutions relative to recommendations for the City's 2019-20 State Legislative Program regarding legislation to adopt a State Historic Rehabilitation Tax Credit, and to amend the State Government Code to allow homeless shelters on private land during declared emergencies. The CLA report and Resolutions, attached to the Council file, provide additional background information.

After consideration, and after providing an opportunity for public comment, the Committee recommended that Council adopt the Resolutions. This matter is now forwarded to the Council for its consideration.
