Summary: At its March 27, 2019 Brown-Act publicly-noticed regular board meeting, the BABCNC voted unanimously to support the State Assembly Bill AB 1788 (Bloom) as amended, regarding pesticides: use of anticoagulants: The bill was AMENDED IN ASSEMBLY MARCH 19, 2019 Calif. Legislature 2019–20 regular session ASSEMBLY BILL No. 1788 introduced by Assembly Member Bloom February 22, 2019: An act to amend Section 12978.7 of, and to add Section 12978.8 to, the Food and Agricultural Code, relating to pesticides. The BABCNC therefore supports including in its 2019-20 State Legislative Program SUPPORT for AB 1788 (Bloom), which would expand the prohibition of pesticide that contains one or more of specified anticoagulants in wildlife areas, as defined; and would expand the prohibition to the entire state; and would also prohibit the use of any pesticide that contains one or more specifically identified anticoagulants on state-owned property.
