

RULES, ELECTIONS, AND INTERGOVERNMENTAL RELATIONS COMMITTEE REPORT relative to establishing the City's position regarding AB 1417 (Rubio), which would prohibit the operator of an online platform or application from displaying for the sale of cannabis products.

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Resolution (Wesson - Koretz), SUBJECT TO THE CONCURRENCE OF THE MAYOR:

ADOPT the accompanying RESOLUTION to include in the City's 2019-20 State Legislative Program, SUPPORT for AB 1417 (Rubio) which would prohibit the operator of an online platform or application from displaying for the sale of cannabis products unless the advertisement displays the license number of the cannabis business, and would allow for civil action for violations of cannabis advertisement and marketing requirements.

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the Chief Legislative Analyst (CLA). The City Administrative Officer has not completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

At a special meeting held on April 16, 2019, the Rules, Elections, and Intergovernmental Relations Committee considered a Resolution relative to establishing the City's position to support AB 1417 (Rubio) which would prohibit the operator of an online platform or application from displaying for the sale of cannabis products unless the advertisement displays the license number of the cannabis business, and would allow for civil action for violations of cannabis advertisement and marketing requirements.

After providing an opportunity for public comment, the Rules, Elections, and Intergovernmental Relations Committee approved the CLA's recommendation to adopt the Resolution. This matter is now forwarded to Council for its consideration.
