Dear REIRC Chair and City Council President Wesson and Members Harris-Dawson and Martinez:

Pacific Palisades Community Council (PPCC) -- the most broad-based community organization and voice of the Palisades since 1973 -- opposes Senate Bill 50 and has called upon the City Council to take a position in opposition. See [PPCC Position Letter](#) of February 16, 2019.

PPCC strongly supports the resolution sponsored by Councilmembers Koretz and Harris-Dawson in the above-referenced file and urges the REIRC to schedule this matter for consideration on an expedited basis. **Time is of the essence**, as the bill has already passed in the Senate Housing Committee and is now scheduled to be heard on April 24 in the Senate Committee on Finance & Governance. We note that the City's Chief Legislative Analyst appropriately recommends adoption of the resolution, on the principal grounds that "opposition to SB 50 is consistent with the City's policy to oppose legislation that constrains its local control."
