Beginning on January 9, 2019, an individual dubbed the "Chaparral Bandit" has committed seven armed robberies at a number of businesses in the City of Los Angeles, including a Café & Restaurant in Hollywood Hills that he has robbed three times. This individual, described as a black male in his 30s or 40s, standing approximately 6'07" and weighing about 180 lbs., usually enters a business he is targeting, points a handgun at employees and demands money from the cash register before demanding an employee open any safe on site and taking the money inside. He then flees the location in an unknown direction. Detectives and continuing to investigate these crimes and believe that a reward may compel members of the public to provide information on the identity of the person responsible for these crimes. The person or persons responsible for this crime represent an ongoing threat to the safety of the people of Los Angeles. Unless withdrawn or paid by City Council action, this offer of reward shall terminate on, and have no effect after, DECEMBER 23, 2019.

The provisions of payment and all other considerations shall be governed by Chapter 12 of Division 19 of the LAAC Code, as amended by Ordinance Nos. 198157 and 198966.
