Since October 15, 2018, 26 homes in the areas of North Hollywood and Sun Valley roughly bounded by Roscoe Boulevard in the north, Victory Boulevard in the south, the 170 freeway to the east and the Tujunga Wash to the west have been burglarized by the same individuals. The suspects in these burglaries target single family homes in this area with minimal or no lighting, and gain access to the homes by smashing rear sliding glass doors. The thieves then look for cash, jewelry, designer handbags and firearms. Detectives are continuing to investigate these crimes, and believe that a reward may compel members of the public to provide information on the identity of the persons responsible for this series of burglaries. The person or persons responsible for this crime represent an ongoing threat to the safety of the people of Los Angeles. Unless withdrawn or paid by City Council action, this offer of reward shall terminate on, and have no effect after, AUGUST 20, 2019.
