

The Street Furniture Revenue Fund provides funds for transit-related projects, sidewalk projects, curb/sidewalk improvements, beautification projects needed to improve conditions for public transit patrons, and all expenses relating or incidental thereto, as well as on general services to the community in each Council District.

Council District 11 has partnered with the Westchester Streetscape Improvement Association to beautify and update the S. Sepulveda Boulevard corridor between Manchester Avenue and W. Centinela Avenue. This effort includes tree removal and planting, new sidewalk construction, and landscape improvements to the streetscape. The Department of Transportation is further repairing any incidental transit infrastructure repairs that will be incurred as a direct result of the efforts of the Westchester Streetscape Improvement Association. This effort is of special benefit for the residents of the City and for Council District 11 and deserves financial assistance from the City.

Sufficient funds are available in the Council District 11 portion of the Street Furniture Revenue Fund which could appropriately be transferred to the Department of Transportation for this purpose.

I THEREFORE MOVE that \$18,500 from the Council District 11 portion of the Street Furniture Revenue Fund No. 43D, Department 50 be transferred to the Department of Transportation Trust Fund 840 and appropriate therefrom to a new appropriation account within the same fund to pay for the repair of transit infrastructure along the S. Sepulveda Boulevard corridor between Manchester Avenue and W. Centinela Avenue.

I FURTHER MOVE that the Department of Transportation be authorized to make clarification or corrections to the above instructions as may be necessary to implement the intent of this Motion.
