Summary: "The Del Rey Neighborhood Council strongly supports CF 19-0046, a motion introduced by Councilmember David Ryu to amend the City's campaign finance laws, similar to the Measure H restrictions approved by Los Angeles voters in 2011, to prohibit contributions to City elected officials and candidates for City office from "Restricted Developers." "Restricted Developers" would be defined to include the owner(s) of real property (and if ownership is held in the name of a legal entity, the term would also include the principals of the entity), when (a) an application for any significant Planning Entitlement Process administered by the Department of City Planning for the property has been filed, and (b) the completion of the Planning Entitlement Process requires approval or other action by City elected officials or candidates for City office, and (c) the Planning Entitlement Process involved would allow the construction or addition of more than 4,000 square feet of residential floor area or 15,000 square feet of commercial floor area. The prohibition on contributions would extend from the date of the application to a date twelve (12) months following the final resolution of the application. The prohibition would also restrict City officials from requesting, and developers and their principals from providing, behested payments under the same conditions."
