- 1a) REQUEST the City Attorney to AMEND LAMC Section 49.5.2 to include the definition of a development applicant as a restricted source as defined in the proposed section 49.7.38.
- 2a) Clarify that a restricted developer includes both the property owners and project applicants.
- 2b) Remove the square footage exemption and define that property owners and project applicants subject to contribution restrictions, as recommended by the Department of City Planning, are those seeking the following planning approvals:
