Summary:

On February 6, 2018, your Committee considered a January 11, 2019 RAP report relative to the exemption of one Chief Management Analyst, one Project Coordinator, and one Senior Project Coordinator (Class Codes 9182, 1537, and 1538, respectively) positions for the RAP from the Civil Service provisions of the City Charter pursuant to Charter Section 1001(d)(4). According to the RAP, the Chief Management Analyst position was allocated by the Board of Civil Service Commissioners (CSC) and exempted from civil service on January 10, 2019. The Project Coordinator and Senior Project Coordinator are previously allocated positions that were exempted by the CSC from civil service on January 10, 2019. The exemption request is to exempt all the positions from civil service is on the basis that they are grant-funded positions. After consideration and having provided an opportunity for public comment, the Committee moved to recommend approval of the exemptions for the RAP as detailed in the above recommendation.
