Summary: At its 03/27/2019 Brown-Act publicly noticed regular board meeting, the Bel Air-Beverly Crest Neighborhood Council (BABCNC) voted to oppose legalization of video advertisements mounted on taxicabs and for-hire vehicles (including services such as Lyft and Uber); and to support the motion by Councilmember Blumenfield to change TaxiCab Rule 415(c), as set forth in his motion in Council File 19-0104, which states: "I THEREFORE MOVE that the Los Angeles City Council request the City Attorney to prepare and present a draft ordinance to repeal Taxicab Board Rule 415(c). I FURTHER MOVE that the City Council request the Department of Transportation and the Los Angeles Police Department to take enforcement action against persons who operate vehicles with attached DMS devices within the City of Los Angeles."
