

ENERGY, CLIMATE CHANGE, AND ENVIRONMENTAL JUSTICE COMMITTEE REPORT relative to proposed Measure W eligible projects that will help in efforts to remediate and recharge the San Fernando Groundwater Basin (SFB).

Recommendations for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Krekorian - Martinez - Rodriguez - Blumenfield):

1. INSTRUCT the Los Angeles Department of Water and Power (LADWP) and the Bureau of Sanitation (BOS), with assistance of the Chief Legislative Analyst (CLA), to report back with a list of proposed Measure W eligible projects that will directly aid efforts to remediate and recharge the SFB, including current project status and budget, as well as recommendations for immediate implementation of the highest priority projects.
2. INSTRUCT the LADWP and the BOS to develop a plan that specifically details their efforts to collaboratively work together to address the contamination within the SFB, including past and future conveyance, capture, and recharge projects that both agencies are undertaking and proposed funding sources for each project.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the CLA has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

At its regular meeting held on March 19, 2019, the Energy, Climate Change, and Environmental Justice Committee considered Motion (Krekorian - Martinez - Rodriguez - Blumenfield) relative to a list of proposed Measure W eligible projects that will directly aid efforts to remediate and recharge the SFB.

After providing an opportunity for public comment, the Committee moved to approve the recommendations contained in the Motion, as detailed above. This matter is now transmitted to the Council for its consideration.
