

MOTION

On February 7, 2019, Bureau of Engineering staff inspected a potential sinkhole between 8357 and 8361 West Yucca Trail. At this location, Los Angeles Department of Water and Power crews are installing a new water main on the roadway and there is concern about the stability of the street. Erosion gullies on the majority of the surrounding slopes have developed, likely from recent rain events. With additional rain expected, further deterioration of the roadway may occur. The estimated cost to repair the damage is \$50,000. The repair will be performed by a contractor from the Bureau of Engineering's Pre-Qualified On-Call contractors list and construction is expected to last approximately one to two weeks.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the City Council, subject to the approval of the Mayor, APPROPRIATE/TRANSFER \$50,000 from the Capital Improvements Expenditure Program (CIEP), Fund 100, Dept. 54, Account 00R234, entitled "Contingency for Construction" to a new account in CIEP, Fund 100, Dept. 54, to be entitled "West Yucca Trail Sinkhole Project."

I FURTHER MOVE that the City Administrative Officer be authorized to make any technical changes as necessary to effectuate the intent of this motion.
