INTERNET CRIMES AGAINST CHILDREN PROGRAM FROM THE CALIFORNIA GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF EMERGENCY SERVICES

RECOMMENDED ACTIONS

1. That the Board of Police Commissioners (Board) REVIEW and APPROVE this report.

- 2. That the Board TRANSMIT the attached grant application and award, pursuant to Administrative Code Section 14.6(a), to the Mayor, Office of the City Administrative Officer (CAO), Office of the Chief Legislative Analyst and to the City Clerk for Committee and City Council consideration.
- 3. That the Board REQUEST the Mayor and City Council to:
 - A. AUTHORIZE the Chief of Police to retroactively APPLY for and ACCEPT the grant award for the Internet Crimes Against Children (ICAC) Program in the amount of \$1,000,000 for the period of July 1, 2018 through December 31, 2020, from the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services (CAL OES);
 - B. AUTHORIZE the Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD) to spend up to the grant amount of \$1,000,000 in accordance with the grant award agreement;
 - C. AUTHORIZE the Chief of Police or his designee to negotiate and execute the Cooperative Agreement, subject to City Attorney approval as to form and legality;
 - D. AUTHORIZE the LAPD to submit grant reimbursement requests to the grantor and deposit grant receipts in Fund No. 339, Department No. 70;
 - E. AUTHORIZE the Controller to set up a grant receivable and appropriate \$1,000,000 to an appropriation account to be determined within Fund No. 339, Department No. 70, for the receipt and disbursement of the ICAC Program in accordance with the grant award agreement;
 - F. AUTHORIZE the Controller to increase appropriations for Cal OES's FY 2018 ICAC Program as needed from appropriation account number to be determined in Fund No. 339, Department No. 70, to Fund No. 100, Department No. 70, account number and amount as follows:

Account No. 001090, Civilian Overtime \$ 25,350 Account No. 001092, Sworn Overtime \$ 64,800

G. INSTRUCT the City Clerk to place on Council Calendar July 1, 2019, the following action relative to the Cal OES's FY 2018 ICAC program, that the City Council, subject to the approval of the Mayor, authorize the Controller to transfer \$25, 050 from Fund No. 339, Department No. 70, account number to be determined, to Fund No. 100, Department No. 70, account number and amount as follows:

Account No. 001090, Civilian Overtime \$ 12,350 Account No. 001092, Sworn Overtime \$ 32,400

H. INSTRUCT the City Clerk to place on Council Calendar July 1, 2020, the following action relative to the Cal OES's FY 2018 ICAC program, that the City Council, subject to the approval of the Mayor, authorize the Controller to transfer \$12,350 from Fund No. 339, Department No. 70, account number to be determined, to Fund No. 100, Department No. 70, account number and amount as follows:

Account No. 001090, Civilian Overtime \$ 12,350 Account No. 001092, Sworn Overtime \$ 32,400

- I. AUTHORIZE the Chief of Police or his designee to negotiate and execute either new agreements or to amend any agreements with affiliate task force agencies, subject to the approval of the City Attorney; and
- J. AUTHORIZE the LAPD to prepare Controller Instructions for any technical adjustments, subject to the approval of the CAO, and AUTHORIZE and INSTRUCT the Controller to implement the instructions.

DISCUSSION

Funds provided under this program are intended to:

- Ensure local and law enforcement agencies are better equipped to investigate computer crimes against children by offenders using the Internet, on-line communication systems, and other technologies;
- Prosecute cases at the local, state and federal level:
- Provide educational programs and computer safety tips for law enforcement officers, teachers, parents, and children;
- Serve as a forensic resource to law enforcement agencies within the service area;
- Participate in nationally-coordinated investigations.

The LAPD will allocate \$129,600 for sworn overtime, \$50,050 for civilian overtime, \$475,100 for various equipment that include four customized vehicles equipped to handle the rigorous demands of the Task Force. In addition, the LAPD will also allocate \$345,250 for operating expenses that include various forensic and software licenses, secured parking for response vehicles, internet access and various supplies to maintain day-to-day operations of the Task Force.
