

PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to acceptance of a grant award for the Internet Crimes Against Children (ICAC) Program from the California Governor's Office of Emergency Service (Cal OES).

Recommendations for Council action, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:

1. AUTHORIZE the Chief, Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD), or designee, to:
 - a. Retroactively apply for and subsequently accept the grant award in the amount of \$1,000,000 for the 2018 ICAC Program from the Cal OES for the period of July 1, 2018 through December 31, 2020.
 - b. Negotiate and execute the Cooperative Agreement, subject to the approval of the City Attorney as to form.
 - c. Negotiate and execute either new agreements or to amend any agreements with affiliate task force agencies, subject to the approval of the City Attorney as to form.
 - d. Spend up to the total grant amount of \$1,000,000 in accordance with the grant award agreement.
 - e. Submit grant reimbursement requests to the grantor and deposit the grant receipts in the LAPD Grants Fund No. 339/70.
 - f. Prepare Controller instructions for any technical adjustments, subject to the approval of the City Administrative Officer (CAO); and, authorize the Controller to implement the instructions.
2. AUTHORIZE the Controller to:
 - a. Establish a grant receivable and appropriate \$1,000,000 to appropriation account, account number to be determined, within Fund No. 339/70, for the receipt and disbursement of 2018 ICAC Program grant funds.
 - b. Increase appropriations for the 2018 ICAC Program grant as needed from Appropriations Account No. to be determined, in Fund No. 339/70, to Fund No. 100/70, account numbers and amounts as follows:

3. AUTHORIZE the City Clerk to:

Fiscal Impact Statement: The CAO reports that approval of the recommendations within this report will allow for the retroactive approval and subsequent acceptance and expenditure of the 2018 ICAC Grant Program from the Cal OES, totaling \$1,000,000. No matching funds are required for this grant. Approval of the recommendations in this report will have no additional impact on the General Fund. Acceptance of the grant is in compliance with the City's financial policies in that one-time revenue is used for one-time expenses.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

At its regular meeting held on May 22, 2019, the Public Safety Committee considered CAO and Board of Police Commissioners reports relative to the acceptance of a \$1,000,000 grant award for the ICAC Program from the Cal OES. The primary purpose of the ICAC Program is to ensure law enforcement agencies are equipped to quickly respond to, investigate, and prosecute incidents involving the exploitation of children and juveniles through the use of the internet.

After providing an opportunity for public comment, the Committee recommended to approve the recommendations in the CAO report, detailed above. This matter is now submitted to the Council for consideration.
