MOTION

The California Natural Resources Agency is offering a grant opportunity under the Urban Greening program. The Bureau of Engineering (BOE) has identified the North Atwater East Bank RiverWay Project (Project) as a competitive project to submit for funding.

The Project would convert approximately 2.2 miles of a maintenance road into multi-use trail along the Los Angeles Riverfront through Atwater Village and Glassell Park from the Verdugo Wash to Los Feliz Boulevard. This improved section of RiverWay would connect residents and path users along the east bank of the Los Angeles River who will also be able to use the in-construction North Atwater Bridge to cross the River and connect to the west bank bikeway. The Project would include native plants, porous trail surfaces, and stormwater swales for water resilience, as well as features to interpret the natural and cultural history of the River. Reclaimed materials and recycled water usage would reduce its consumption impact. Currently, the project area is a single-use maintenance road that is a magnet for graffiti and illegal dumping.

The grant application will seek up to \$2,200,000 to fund the North Atwater East Bank RiverWay improvements. The final grant application requires the approval of a pre-approved State format Resolution. The Resolution certifies that the City of Los Angeles designates the Bureau of Engineering with authority to submit and execute the grant.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the Bureau of Engineering be authorized to apply for grant funding in the approximate amount up to \$2,200,000 for the North Atwater East Bank RiverWay Project from the California Natural Resources Agency, as further described in the text of this Motion.

I FURTHER MOVE that should funding be awarded, the Bureau of Engineering authorized to negotiate and execute a grant agreement and other agreements as necessary and to receive funding for the above grant.

I FURTHER MOVE that the Council adopt the attached Resolution required by the California Natural Resources Agency as part of the grant application process.

- 4. Certifies that it will comply with the provisions of Section 1771.5 of the State Labor Code, and
- If applicable, certifies that the project will comply with any laws and regulations including, but not limited to, legal requirements for building codes, health and safety codes, disabled access laws, environmental laws and, that prior to commencement of construction, all applicable permits will have been obtained, and
- Certifies that applicant will work towards the Governor's State Planning Priorities intended to promote equity, strengthen the economy, protect the environment, and promote public health and safety as included in Government Code Section 65041.1, and
- Appoints the City Engineer, or designee, as agent to conduct all negotiations, execute and submit all documents including, but not limited to applications, agreements, payment requests and so on, which may be necessary for the completion of the aforementioned project(s).
