

PUBLIC WORKS AND GANG REDUCTION COMMITTEE REPORT relative to conducting an assessment of 16 alleys to undertake a determination of the scope of repairs necessary to remedy the current condition of these alleys.

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Harris-Dawson - Blumenfield - Price):

- INSTRUCT the Bureau of Street Services (BSS) and Bureau of Engineering (BOE) to conduct an immediate assessment of the identified alleys set forth below and to undertake a determination of the scope of repairs necessary to remedy the current condition of these alleys:

 - n. Avalon (east west) and 97th to 98th Street (north south) SR No. 1-1313620351
 - o. 8100 South Hoover Street SR No. 1-1313619851
 - p. 4510 Cimarron SR No. 1-1313649881
- INSTRUCT the City Administrative Officer (CAO) to identify funding to undertake the repairs recommended by BSS and BOE on the above alleys and report to Council within 30 days.
