Summary: We support Council File #19-0307 as written, which requests timely multi-jurisdictional status reporting on critical safety measures along the Pacoima Wash. To summarize those requests, the report should include: 1) the status and enforcement of trespassing laws and efforts to strengthen enforcement capabilities; 2) responsibilities and funding for installing and maintaining fencing and other safety infrastructure related to deterring trespassing and; 3) the status of City infrastructure located throughout Pacoima Wash and an assessment of any necessary repairs or improvements required to address damage caused by trespassing in the Wash. Further, we support the request in Council File #19-0307 that the Bureau of Sanitation and the City Administrative Officer be instructed to identify and report on available funding sources to address safety issues in the Pacoima Wash, including an analysis of the feasibility of utilizing Measure W funds.
