This item is to approve the Sustainable Communities Environmental Assessment (SCEA) for the future consideration of the development project identified in Planning Case numbers <b>ZA-2018-3985-MCUP-TOC-WDI-SPR</b> and <b>VTT-82171-CN</b> . Public Resources Code (PRC) Section 21155.2 requires the City Council to adopt findings and the SCEA prior to project approval if the City Council is not the decision-maker on the project approvals. Planning has reviewed and circulated the SCEA as required by law and is now recommending the SCEA for the City Council's consideration and adoption.				
The SCEA (ENV-2018-3986-SCEA) concludes that all potentially significant environmental impacts can be mitigated to less than significant. Mitigation measures are proposed for the following impact areas: Cultural Resources, Noise, and Transportation/Circulation. This location is not a site on any of the lists enumerated under Gov. Code Section 65962.5. Pursuant to Section 21155.2 of the PRC, this SCEA Initial Study: 1) incorporates all feasible mitigation measures, performance standards, or criteria set forth in the prior applicable environmental impact reports, including the Program EIR (PEIR) for the 2016-2040 Regional Transportation of Governments (SCAG), and adopted in findings made pursuant to Section 21081; and 2) contains mitigation measures that either avoid or mitigate to a level of insignificance all potentially significant or significant effects of the Project required to be identified in this initial study.

ADOPT the SCEA (ENV-2018-3986-SCEA), the MMP and the Mitigation Measures for the proposed mixeduse development that involves the construction, use, and maintenance of a 222,944 square-foot, 31-story, mixed-use tower with 256 residential units and 2,507 square feet of office floor area, including the change of use of an existing, 12,800 square-foot building to commercial floor area, and that will set aside 29 units (11 percent of the total quantity of units) for Extremely Low Income Households, and include 329 automobile parking spaces, 141 long-term bicycle parking spaces, and 17 short-term bicycle parking spaces, and 21,450 square feet of open space, for the properties located at 522, 530, 550 South Shatto Place and 3119 West 6th Street.

3. ADOPT the following Findings:

- a. The Proposed Project qualifies as a transit priority project pursuant to Public Resources Code Section 21155;
- b. The Proposed Project incorporates all feasible mitigation measures, performance standards, or criteria set forth in the prior environmental reports, as amended herein, including the RTP/SCS Program Environmental Impact Report;
- c. All potentially significant or significant effects required to be identified and analyzed pursuant to CEQA in an initial study have been identified and analyzed; and
- d. With respect to each significant effect on the environment required to be identified in the initial study, changes or alterations have been required in or incorporated into the project that avoids or mitigates the significant effects to a level of insignificance.
