## MOTIONECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

Motion (O'Farrell-Martinez) (C.F. 14-1174-S41), approved by City Council on June 27, 2018, allocated all taxable CRA/LA Excess Bond Proceeds available to Council District 13, from the Westlake Redevelopment Project Area to be utilized by the Los Angeles Department of Transportation to assist in the implementation of the Union Avenue Elementary School Safe Routes to School project. Improvements resulting from the project may include, but are not limited to, crosswalk enhancements, speed bumps, traffic signals, and safety patrols.

The Motion stated that the use of taxable CRA/LA Excess Bond Proceeds towards a Safe Routes to School project in the Westlake Redevelopment Project Area is identified as an eligible expense in the Bond Expenditure Agreement and Bond Spending Plan. However, subsequent to approval of the Motion, it was determined that the Union Avenue Elementary School was not explicitly listed as an eligible Safe Routes to School project in the Bond Spending Plan for the Westlake Redevelopment Project Area. An amendment to the Bond Expenditure Agreement and Bond Spending Plan is needed to allow the use of CRA/LA Excess Bond Proceeds to fund the project.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the Council request the Mayor to pursue an amendment to the Bond Expenditure Agreement to include the "Union Avenue Elementary School Safe Routes to School Project" in the Bond Spending Plan for the Westlake Redevelopment Project Area.
