MOTION

The Department of Public Works (DPW), Bureau of Engineering (BOE) and the Los Angeles Department of Water & Power (LADWP) have an existing Memorandum of Understanding (DPW-LADWP MOU) where LADWP allocates funds toward the cost of relocating LADWP's facilities that interfere with DPW projects. BOE contractors are in the process of implementing three Active Transportation Program (ATP) projects which require utility relocations.

Currently, LADWP cannot commit to relocate certain utilities with LADWP crews or contractors. LADWP has proposed to transfer the necessary funding to BOE. The funding will be utilized to relocate LADWP facilities, including the planning, design, and/or construction phases which may be performed by BOE staff, contractors and/or consultants. BOE has verified with the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) that this action will not put the ATP grant related to these projects at risk.

I THEREFORE MOVE, that the City Council, subject to the approval of the Mayor AUTHORIZE the Department of Public Works to:

 Establish new project accounts in the Engineering Special Services Fund, Fund 682, Department 50 and accept and deposit funds from the Los Angeles Department of Water and Power (LADWP) in an amount up to \$535,000 to new accounts as follows:

 Transfer surplus funds back to LADWP upon completion of the above identified projects, including proper documentation from the City Engineer.

I FURTHER MOVE that the Department of Public Works be authorized to make any technical corrections or clarifications to the above instructions in order to effectuate the intent of this Motion.
