

ADOPTED BUDGET RECOMMENDATION

Request the Los Angeles Homeless Services Authority (LAHSA) to report to the Homelessness and Poverty Committee on LAHSA's programs to address family homelessness. The report should address how LAHSA programs facilitate the transition of families from motels to stable housing, its strategy to address the needs of homeless families, and the resources needed to implement innovative models specific to families with children living in motels, such as the LA Family Housing "It Takes a Village" proposal (C.F. No. 19-0411).
