

HEALTH, EDUCATION, NEIGHBORHOODS, PARKS, ARTS, AND RIVER COMMITTEE

Recommendation for Council action:

AUTHORIZE the Department of Recreation and Parks (RAP), to submit various applications for  
the Proposition 68 Statewide Park Development and Community Revitalization Program Round  
Three Grant, to the State of California, Department of Parks and Recreations.

Fiscal Impact Statement: The RAP reports that there is no fiscal impact to the General Fund at  
this time; however, future maintenance costs have yet to be determined.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.
