

MOTION

In 1973, Mayor Tom Bradley established the Bicycle Advisory Committee (BAC) to advance the bicycle as a means of recreation and transportation in the City. Over the years, members of the BAC have been instrumental in hiring the City's first Bicycle Coordinator, the development of the first Bicycle Plan included in the City's General Plan Transportation Element, encouraging and supporting projects such as the Los Angeles River Bicycle Path and various bicycle lanes, as well as securing funding and coordinating the development of a variety of projects in the City.

On February 3, 2009, the Council approved changes to the BAC, including the allocation of staff resources, affirming the composition of the BAC membership, and adding a policy for the selection of the BAC Chair (C.F. 08-0475). As the City continues to expand bicycle infrastructure and encourage the use of bicycles as a viable mode of transportation, many critical items are agendaized for the monthly BAC meetings. It is important that the City expand BAC membership to include alternates to ensure that all areas of the City are represented at meetings and that there are always a sufficient number of voting members to take action on agenda items.


