

INFORMATION, TECHNOLOGY, AND GENERAL SERVICES COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the City's current independent Information Technology (IT) networks as well as the status of any upcoming independent network projects.

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Blumenfield - Bonin):

INSTRUCT the General Manager, Information Technology Agency, to lead a committee that includes, but is not limited to, the City Administrative Officer (CAO), Los Angeles Department of Transportation, Los Angeles Department of Water and Power, Los Angeles Police Department, Department of Public Works, Department of Recreation and Parks, Bureau of Sanitation, Los Angeles World Airports, Port of Los Angeles and Emergency Management Department to provide the City Council and Mayor with a report that will provide an overview of the City's (including proprietary agencies') current independent IT networks as well as the status of any upcoming independent network projects. Further, the report shall provide an overview of how these networks could be consolidated; and the costs and benefits of such a consolidation of either current networks or of future networks that are being considered by City Departments. This report shall be submitted to the Mayor and Council no later than 90 days from the date that this motion is adopted by the City Council.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the CAO nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

At its special meeting held on August 14, 2019, the Information, Technology, and General Services Committee considered Motion (Blumenfield - Bonin) relative to directing the ITA to lead a committee that includes various City Departments to provide an overview of the City's current independent information technology networks as well as the status of any upcoming independent network projects.

After providing an opportunity for public comment, the Committee moved to approve the recommendation contained in the Motion, as detailed above. This matter is now transmitted to the Council for its consideration.
