MOTION

El Grito de Dolores marks the beginning of the Mexican War of Independence and is celebrated September 15th of each year. This annual celebration on City Hall Spring Street steps entertains residents with a large event that will feature music, special guests, and a reenactment of the historic cry and bell ringing (the "official portion"). The Sixth Council District is preparing for a large scale family event to continue in this tradition.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the Council adopt the following recommendations relative to funding to cover the cost of El Grito:

- 1. Transfer \$57,001.96 from the General Services Trust Fund 843/40, Account 40280M, EL GRITO, to the General Services Trust Fund 843/40, Account 40280S, EL GRITO.
- 2. Transfer \$5,000 each for Council Districts 1, 6, 7, 9, 10, 14, and \$2,500 for Council District 8 and \$1,000 for Council District 13 portions of the Council Civic Fund, from Cultural Affairs Fund 100, Account 009699, Council Civic Fund, total \$33,500, to the General Services Trust Fund 843/40 Account 40280S, EL GRITO, as well as additional funding from the Mayor's Office.
- 3. Transfer \$5,000 for Council District 4 portion of Redevelopment Projects State AB1290 City Fund No. 53P, Account 281204, to the General Services Trust Fund 843/40 Account 40280S, EL GRITO.
- 4. That the Department of General Services be instructed and authorized to enter and execute a contract for the 2019 El Grito celebration, subject to the approval of the City Attorney as to form and legality, and to make expenditures associated with this year's event utilizing funds identified in the text of this motion.

I FURTHER MOVE that the Department of General Services be allowed to make corrections, clarifications, and technical adjustments as needed to implement this motion and the Council's intent.
