Summary: The Arroyo Seco Neighborhood Council (ASNC) extends its support to this motion (19-0718) calling for the City Attorney's office to report on an analysis of statewide eviction protection laws that can be adopted in Los Angeles to safeguard tenants from eviction. While the city is currently bound to the limitations on renter protections due to the Costa-Hawkins and Ellis acts there may be other legislative options to provide protections to renters vis-à-vis evictions. With over 500,000 evictions in the County of Los Angeles since 2010 and potentially more who have vacated merely from the threat of eviction the City of Los Angeles must act in order to protect its citizens during the current housing crisis. It is because of this that the Arroyo Seco Neighborhood Council supports this council motion.
