MOTION

I MOVE that the Council ADOPT the following recommendations in order to pay the judgment against the City in the case entitled <u>James Pearl v. City of Los Angeles</u>, Court of Appeal State of California Second Appellate District Nos. B285235 and B286993 and Los Angeles Superior Court No. BC518568 (this matter involves an appeal from a judgment entered after a jury verdict in favor of plaintiff James Pearl), **SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR**:

- 1. AUTHORIZE the City Attorney and Public Works, Bureau of Sanitation to expend up to \$14,033,800.65 plus applicable interest in judgment of the above-entitled matter.
- AUTHORIZE the Controller to appropriate \$13,000,000 within Sewer Operations and Maintenance Fund No. 760/50 from available cash balance to Account No. TBD, and further transfer to the Liability Claims Fund No. 100/59, Account No. 009794, Public Works, Sanitation Liability Payouts.
- 3. AUTHORIZE Public Works, Bureau of Sanitation to pay the past and future economic losses as set on the Court's judgment in the amount of \$2,394,972 from Fund No. 100/82, Appropriation Unit No. 001010.
- 4. AUTHORIZE the City Attorney to draw two demands from Fund No. 100/59, Account No. 009794, Public Works, Sanitation Liability Payouts, as follows:
 - a. \$11,638,828.65 plus applicable interest, made payable to Scolinos, Sheldon & Nevell and James Pearl.
 - b. The interest applicable to \$2,394,972, for the past and future economic losses, made payable to Scolinos, Sheldon & Nevell and James Pearl.
- 5. AUTHORIZE the City Attorney, or designee, to make necessary technical adjustments, subject to the approval of the City Administrative Officer; and, AUTHORIZE the Controller to implement the instructions.
