

MOTION

The intersection and adjacent roadway in the vicinity of Sepulveda Boulevard and Valley Meadow Road in Council District 5 has proven to be very problematic and oftentimes dangerous. In this area, not only do drivers along Sepulveda Boulevard experience extremely sharp curves as they approach the intersection, but naturally occurring groundwater in the area causes the roadway to be slippery.

In addition to the dangerous curve of the road and accumulating groundwater, as drivers travel north and downhill on Sepulveda Boulevard, speed becomes a factor. There have been numerous accidents in recent years whereby drivers have crashed directly into the wall of the private property on the northwest corner of the intersection. The installation of a guard rail along Sepulveda Boulevard would prevent further damage to the private property and lessen the force of a vehicle collision.

The Bureau of Engineering has evaluated this location and recommends the installation of 120 lineal feet of Metal Beam Guard-Rail at an estimated cost of \$30,000. Council District 5 has offered to provide \$15,000 of the total amount from the Council District 5 portion of the Street Furniture Revenue Fund for this project. The identification of the remaining \$15,000 will allow for the installation of the guardrail and further protection for the adjacent property owners and drivers in the area.


I THEREFORE MOVE that the City Administrative Officer be directed to report within 30 days with the identification of \$15,000 to supplement the installation of 120 lineal feet of Metal Beam Guard-Rail along Sepulveda Boulevard at the intersection of Valley Meadow Road.
