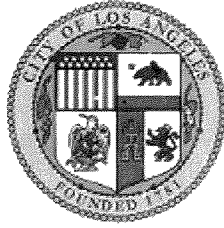

**CERTIFICATION OF ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT REPORT (EIR) AND PROJECT APPROVAL  
FOR THE PASEO DEL MAR PERMANENT RESTORATION PROJECT**

As recommended in the accompanying report of the City Engineer, which this Board has adopted, the Board of Public Works (Board) recommends that the City Council:

1. CERTIFY that the Project Final EIR (Transmittal Nos. 1 and 2) was completed in compliance with the CEQA; that the Final EIR was presented to the Council, as the decision-making body of the City of Los Angeles (City), and that the Council reviewed and considered the information contained in the Final EIR; and that the Final EIR reflects and expresses the City's independent judgment and analysis;
2. ADOPT the Findings and Statement of Overriding Considerations (Transmittal No. 3);
3. ADOPT the Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Program (Transmittal No. 4);
4. SPECIFY that the documents constituting the record of proceedings in this matter are in the custody of the City Clerk, located at 200 North Spring Street, Los Angeles, CA 90012 and in the files of the Department of Public Works Bureau of Engineering (BOE), located at 1149 South Broadway, Suite 600, Los Angeles, CA 90015; and
5. APPROVE the Bridge Spanning Over Landslide Alternative (identified and described as Alternative 1 in the EIR)

The current estimated project budget is \$33,000,000, but funding sources have not been identified.
