

ORDINANCE NO. 186601

An ordinance of the City of Los Angeles abandoning all proceedings relating to the improvement of **COLORADO BOULEVARD IMPROVEMENT NO. 3 Lighting District**, as contemplated by Ordinance No. 186265 and repealing that ordinance.

**THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LOS ANGELES
DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. All proceedings relating to the improvements contemplated by Ordinance of Intention No. 186265 are hereby abandoned.

Sec. 2. Ordinance No. 186265 approved August 13, 2019 is hereby repealed.

Sec. 3. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this ordinance and have it published in accordance with Council policy, either in a daily newspaper circulated in the City of Los Angeles or by posting for ten days in three public places in the City of Los Angeles: one copy on the bulletin board located at the Main Street entrance to the Los Angeles City Hall; one copy on the bulletin board located at the Main Street entrance to the Los Angeles City Hall East; and one copy on the bulletin board located at the Temple Street entrance to the Los Angeles County Hall of Records.
