

HOMELESSNESS AND POVERTY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the evaluation of the property located at 4601 South Figueroa Street to determine suitability as an A Bridge Home program facility.

Recommendations for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Price - Harris-Dawson):

1. INSTRUCT the City Administrative Officer (CAO), with the assistance of the Chief Legislative Analyst (CLA), the Bureau of Engineering, Los Angeles Homeless Services Authority, and any other affected City stakeholders, to evaluate the site located at 4601 South Figueroa Street, to determine if the property is suitable for development as an A Bridge Home Program facility.
2. INSTRUCT the City Homeless Coordinator, if a property is determined to be suitable for development as an A Bridge Home Program facility, to identify funds for operations at the site, including, but not limited to, State funding and County Measure H revenue.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the CAO nor the CLA has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

At a regular meeting held on December 4, 2019, the Homelessness and Poverty Committee considered a Motion (Price - Harris-Dawson) relative to the evaluation of the property located at 4601 South Figueroa Street to determine its suitability for development as an A Bridge Home Program facility. After an opportunity for public comment, the Committee recommended approval of the Motion. This matter is now submitted to the Council for consideration.
