ENERGY, CLIMATE CHANGE, AND ENVIRONMENTAL JUSTICE COMMITTEE REPORT and ORDINANCE FIRST CONSIDERATION relative to the Arizona Nuclear Power Project (ANPP) Hassayampa Switchyard Interconnection Agreement (Interconnection Agreement) among the Co-Owners of the ANPP Hassayampa Switchyard and Sun Streams 2, LLC.

Recommendations for Council action, SUBJECT TO APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:

- 1. CONCUR with the Board of Water and Power Commissioners' (Board) action of December 10, 2019, Resolution No. 020 109, approving the Interconnection Agreement, DWP No. BP 19-033, between the City of Los Angeles, acting by and through the Los Angeles Department of Water and Power (LADWP); Arizona Public Service Company, an Arizona corporation; El Paso Electric Company, a Texas corporation; Public Service Company of New Mexico, a New Mexico corporation; Salt River Project Agricultural Improvement and Power District, an agricultural improvement district organized and existing under the laws of the State of Arizona (SRP); Southern California Edison, a California corporation; Southern California Public Power Authority, a California public entity (Co-Owners of the ANPP Hassayampa Switchyard); and Sun Streams 2, LLC, a Delaware limited liability company.
- 2. PRESENT and ADOPT the accompanying ORDINANCE, dated January 7, 2020 approving the Interconnection Agreement, DWP No. BP 19-033, between the Co-Owners of the ANPP Hassayampa Switchyard and Sun Streams 2, LLC; and authorizing the Board to act on and approve all future amendments to the Interconnection Agreement, DWP No. JBP 19-033, without further approval by the Council pursuant to Charter Sections 101 and 671, provided that such amendments do not increase the cost or extend the term of the Interconnection Agreement.

<u>Fiscal Impact Statement</u>: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

## SUMMARY

At its regular meeting held on January 21, 2020, the Energy, Climate Change, and Environmental Justice Committee considered Board and City Attorney reports, Resolution and Ordinance relative to the Interconnection Agreement among the Co-Owners of the ANPP Hassayampa Switchyard and Sun Streams 2, LLC. The Interconnection Agreement establishes the costs, terms, and conditions for the construction, operation, and maintenance of facilities needed by Suns Streams 2, LLC for the interconnection of its 150 megawatt (MW) solar-powered generating facility to the ANPP Hassayampa Switchyard.

After providing an opportunity for public comment, the Committee moved to approve the recommendations contained in the Board and City Attorney reports, Resolution, and Ordinance, as detailed above. This matter is now transmitted to the Council for its consideration.
