Recommendations for Council action, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:

- 1. AUTHORIZE the General Manager, Los Angeles Housing and Community Investment Department (HCIDLA), or designee, to:
  - a. Reimburse Metamorphosis on Foothill, L.P., the limited partnership of Clifford Beers Housing Inc., the selected developer of 13574 West Foothill Boulevard, in the amount of \$76,800.92 for environmental remediation costs.
  - b. Prepare Controller instructions or make any necessary technical adjustments consistent with the Mayor and City Council action on this matter, subject to the approval of the City Administrative Officer (CAO).

## 2. AUTHORIZE the Controller to:

- a. Establish a new appropriation account, Account No. 43S767 Metamorphosis on Foothill within the Low and Moderate Income Housing Fund No. 55J/43.
- b. Transfer funding within the HCIDLA Fund No. 43, Low and Moderate Income Housing Fund No. 55J/43 as follows:
