Summary: The Arroyo Seco Neighborhood Council (ASNC) extends its support to this motion (20-0002-S25) adding to the Los Angeles Federal Legislative Program Support for H.R. 5185, The Green New Deal for Public Housing. This House resolution calls for \$180 Billion in federal funds over 10 years to be used to upgrade 1.2 million federally owned homes to include retrofitting for renewable energy such as solar, wind, hydroelectric as well as energy storage and efficiency. This would also include upgrades to previously deferred repairs such as lead abatement and water quality improvements. The bill would also provide resiliency grants to be used towards childcare and senior centers, community gardens, clinics, learning centers and more. It would also repeal the 1999 Faircloth Amendment allowing for construction of new federal public housing. This bill put forward by Rep. Ocasio-Cortez looks at the synergy of our housing shortage and the need to combat climate change and addresses it in a way that combines the efforts while creating thousands of on-site construction jobs. The Arroyo Seco Neighborhood Council supports the City of Los Angeles in adding this resolution to the 2020 Federal Legislative Program.
