Recommendations for Council action, SUBJECT TO THE CONCURRENCE OF THE MAYOR:

- a. ADOPT the accompanying RESOLUTION to include in the City's 2019-20 State Legislative Program, SUPPORT and/or SPONSORSHIP of legislation that would create a State grant program to provide funding to State and local law enforcement agencies for training on de-escalation techniques, crisis intervention tactics and other alternatives to the use of force, as well as training related to serving vulnerable populations.
- b. ADOPT the accompanying RESOLUTION to include in the City's 2019-20 State Legislative Program, SUPPORT for and/or SPONSORSHIP of legislation that would create a grant program to provide funding to State and local law enforcement agencies for the modernization of law enforcement websites and other online tools in order to increase public transparency.

<u>Fiscal Impact Statement</u>: None submitted by the Chief Legislative Analyst. The City Administrative Officer has not completed a financial analysis of this report.

SUMMARY

At a special meeting held on February 7, 2020, the Rules, Elections, and Intergovernmental Relations Committee considered the CLA report and accompanying Resolutions relative to including in the City's 2019-20 State Legislative Program support for law enforcement legislation, of which subjects include the use of force and de-escalation techniques used by sworn peace officers, and modernization of law enforcement websites to increase public transparency. After providing the opportunity for public comment, the Committee moved to adopt the Resolutions, as detailed above. This matter is now transmitted to the Council for its consideration.
