TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE REPORT relative to establishing oversize vehicle parking restrictions along segments of Santa Rita Street and Alonzo Avenue.

Recommendations for Council action, pursuant to Resolution (Koretz – Huizar):

- 1. RESOLVE, pursuant to California Vehicle Code Section 22507, to hereby prohibit the parking of vehicles that are in excess of 22 feet in length or over seven feet in height, during the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m., along Santa Rita Street between Alonzo and Zelzah Avenues, and Alonzo Avenue between Santa Rita and Tarzana Streets.
- DIRECT the Los Angeles Department of Transportation (LADOT), upon approval of this action, to post signs giving notice of a Tow Away, No Parking restriction for oversize vehicles within the specific hours detailed.
- 3. AUTHORIZE the LADOT to make any technical corrections or clarifications to the above instructions in order to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

<u>Fiscal Impact Statement</u>: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

On February 4, 2020, Council considered Resolution (Koretz – Huizar) relative to establishing oversize vehicle parking restrictions along segments of Santa Rita Street and Alonzo Avenue. Resolution states these street segments located adjacent to Crespi Carmelite High School are experiencing public safety issues associated with the parking of oversized vehicles during the daytime for extended periods of time. Council referred Resolution to the Transportation Committee for consideration.

At its meeting held February 12, 2020, the Transportation Committee recommended that Council approve the proposed parking restrictions and related LADOT instructions pursuant to Resolution.
