TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE REPORT relative to establishing oversize vehicle parking restrictions along segments of Rosewood and North Fuller Avenues.

Recommendations for Council action, pursuant to Resolution (Koretz – Huizar):

- RESOLVE, pursuant to California Vehicle Code Section 22507, to hereby prohibit the parking of vehicles that are in excess of 22 feet in length or over seven feet in height, during all or certain hours of the day, along Rosewood Avenue between North Vista Street and North Fuller Avenue.
- 2. DIRECT the Los Angeles Department of Transportation (LADOT), upon approval of this action, to post signs giving notice of a Tow Away, No Parking restriction for oversize vehicles within the specific hours detailed.
- 3. AUTHORIZE the LADOT to make any technical corrections or clarifications to the above instructions in order to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

<u>Fiscal Impact Statement</u>: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

On February 4, 2020, Council considered Resolution (Koretz – Huizar) relative to establishing oversize vehicle parking restrictions along segments of Rosewood and North Fuller Avenues. Resolution states these street segments are experiencing an increased problem with oversized vehicles parking during all hours of the day, constricting travel lanes, blocking visibility as well as the safe exit and entrance to driveways, and creating dangerous situations. Council referred Resolution to the Transportation Committee for consideration.

At its meeting held February 12, 2020, the Transportation Committee recommended that Council approve the proposed parking restrictions and related LADOT instructions pursuant to Resolution.
