TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE REPORT relative to establishing oversize vehicle parking restrictions along a segment of Balboa Boulevard.

Recommendations for Council action, pursuant to Resolution (Koretz – Huizar):

- 1. RESOLVE, pursuant to California Vehicle Code Section 22507, to hereby prohibit the parking of vehicles that are in excess of 22 feet in length or over seven feet in height, during all hours of the day, along Balboa Boulevard between McCormick and Clark Streets.
- 2. DIRECT the Los Angeles Department of Transportation (LADOT), upon approval of this action, to post signs giving notice of a Tow Away, No Parking restriction for oversize vehicles within the specific hours detailed.
- 3. AUTHORIZE the LADOT to make any technical corrections or clarifications to the above instructions in order to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

<u>Fiscal Impact Statement</u>: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

On February 4, 2020, Council considered Resolution (Koretz – Huizar) relative to establishing oversize vehicle parking restrictions along a segment of Balboa Boulevard. Resolution states this street segment is experiencing an increasing problem with oversized vehicles parking for extended periods of time, constricting travel lanes and creating a dangerous situation. Council referred Resolution to the Transportation Committee for consideration.

At its meeting held February 12, 2020, the Transportation Committee recommended that Council approve the proposed parking restrictions and related LADOT instructions pursuant to Resolution, as amended to apply the proposed parking restrictions to all hours of the day.
