## MOTION

The McConnell pedestrian walkway between 86th Pl. and Manchester Ave. is currently unilluminated and a safety hazard. Lighted bollards along the length of this walkway will provide wayfinding, ambiance, and safety improvements for the community of Westchester. In addition to funds from the Council District 11 portion of the Street Furniture Revenue Fund, Westchester Golf Course has contributed \$8,000 to the completion of this project. The total cost for the design and implementation of the project is \$16,000.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the City of Los Angeles accepts the \$8,000 contribution from Westchester Golf Course and deposits those funds in the Council District 11 potion of the Street Furniture Revenue Fund No. 43D, Department 50.

I FURTHER MOVE that \$16,000 in the Council District 11 portion of the Street Furniture Revenue Fund No. 43D, Department 50 be transferred/appropriated to the Street Lighting Fund No. 100-84 as follows: \$3,200 to Account No. 001010 (Salaries), \$3,200 to Account No. 001090 (Overtime) and \$9,600 to Account No. 008780 (Materials) for a project which includes installation of LED Bollards in the McConnell pedestrian walkway between 86th Pl and Manchester Ave. to add illumination to the pedestrian walkway for safety and ambiance.

I FURTHER MOVE that the Bureau of Street Lighting be authorized to make any corrections, clarifications or revisions to the above fund transfer instructions, including any new instructions, in order to effectuate the intent of this Motion, and including any corrections and changes to fund or account numbers; said corrections/clarifications/changes may be made orally, electronically or by any other means.
