MOTION

Council District 12 seeks to partner with the Los Angeles Conservation Corps (LACC), through the Clean and Green program, for services such as median maintenance and beautification, graffiti abatement, alley and street cleanup, and bulky item pickup. The Clean and Green program employs young people, ranging in age from 14 to 21, and helps them gain environmental work experience and build their skills and resume over a number of weeks or months. This partnership will improve neighborhoods throughout Council District 12, while providing life-changing opportunities to young Angelinos.

I THEREFORE MOVE that \$75,915.00 of the Council District 12 portion of the Street Furniture Revenue Fund No. 43D, Department 50 be transferred to the Board of Public Works Fund No. 100-74 Account No. 3040 (Contractual Services) for various street and neighborhood cleanup and maintenance services throughout Council District 12 coordinated by the Los Angeles Conservation Corps.

I FURTHER MOVE that the Board of Public Works, Office of Community Beautification, be authorized to prepare the necessary documents with and/or payments to the Los Angeles Conservation Corps, or any other agency or organization, in the above amount for the above purpose, subject to the approval of the City Attorney as to form.

I FURTHER MOVE that the Department of Public Works Office of Accounting be authorized to make any technical corrections of clarification as necessary to the above instructions in order to effectuate the intent of the motion.
