ADMINISTRATIVE EXEMPTION and TRADE, TRAVEL, AND TOURISM COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the transfer of a Port of Los Angeles (POLA) lease from San Pedro Public Market, LLC, to SPPM Development, LLC for ownership interest in the San Pedro Public Market Project.

Recommendations for Council action:

SUMMARY

In a report to the Board of Harbor Commissioners dated November 14, 2019, POLA requests approval of a proposed consent to transfer POLA Lease No. 915 with San Pedro Public Market, LLC. San Pedro Public Market, LLC, will assign its interest as the sole owner of San Pedro Public Market to a newly-formed entity known as SPPM Development, LLC, wherein Osprey Investors, LLC, will receive a maximum 80 percent ownership interest. SPPM Development, LLC, has negotiated the receipt of a \$30,000,000 equity commitment by Osprey in exchange for ownership interest in the San Pedro Public Market Project. POLA staff states the transfer is not a transfer of rights under the lease but rather it represents a change in control of the San Pedro Public Market Project. On November 21, 2019, the Board of Harbor Commissioners approved POLA's request.

At its meeting held February 4, 2020, the Trade, Travel, and Tourism Committee recommended that Council approve the proposed action, as recommended by the Board of Harbor Commissioners.
