Subject: RESOLUTION NO. 19-9570 – PROPOSED APPROVAL OF SECOND AMENDMENT TO PERSONAL SERVICES AGREEMENTS BETWEEN THE CITY OF LOS ANGELES HARBOR DEPARTMENT, AECOM TECHNICAL SERVICES, INC. AND JACOBS ENGINEERING GROUP, INC. FOR THE ON-CALL ENGINEERING SERVICES FOR MARINE OIL TERMINAL ENGINEERING AND MAINTENANCE STANDARDS (MOTEMS) PROGRAM

Pursuant to Section 373 of the City Charter and Section 10.5 of the Los Angeles Administrative Code, enclosed for your approval is Resolution No. 19-9570 authorizing proposed Second Amendment Agreement No. 19-3470-B between the City of Los Angeles Harbor Department and AECOM Technical Services, Inc. and Second Amendment Agreement No. 19-3471-B between the City of Los Angeles Harbor Department and Jacobs Engineering Group, Inc.; which was approved at the November 21, 2019 meeting of the Board of Harbor Commissioners. The proposed Second Amendments will extend the Agreements by three additional years, for a total of six years, to March 20, 2023. The total compensation under these Agreements remains unchanged at \$7,750,000. The Second Amendments are required at this time in order to accommodate delays to the design and implementation schedule for the Marine Oil Terminal Engineering and Maintenance Standards (MOTEMS) program and to provide continuity of engineering design and engineering support services during construction. The Harbor Department has received an Executive Directive-4 waiver for this item. There is no impact to the General Fund.

RECOMMENDATION FOR CITY COUNCIL:

1. ADOPT the determination by the Board of Harbor Commissioners that the proposed action is administratively exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) in accordance with Article II, Section 2(f) of the Los Angeles City CEQA Guidelines;
2. APPROVE Harbor Department Resolution No. 19-9570 authorizing proposed Second Amendment Agreement No. 19-3470-B between the City of Los Angeles Harbor Department and AECOM Technical Services, Inc. and Second Amendment Agreement No. 19-3471-B between the City of Los Angeles Harbor Department and Jacobs Engineering Group, Inc.; and
3. Return to the Board of Harbor Commissioners for further processing.
