SUBJECT: RESOLUTION NO. 19-9560 – PROPOSED APPROVAL OF FIRST AMENDMENT TO PERSONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF LOS ANGELES HARBOR DEPARTMENT, AND T.Y. LIN INTERNATIONAL FOR ENGINEERING, ARCHITECTURAL, AND LANDSCAPING DESIGN SERVICES FOR THE WILMINGTON WATERFRONT PEDESTRIAN BRIDGE

Pursuant to Section 373 of the City Charter and Section 10.5 of the Los Angeles Administrative Code, enclosed for your approval is Resolution No. 19-9560 authorizing proposed First Amendment Agreement No. 19-3463-A between the City of Los Angeles Harbor Department (Harbor Department) and T.Y. Lin International (T.Y. Lin); which was approved at the November 21, 2019 meeting of the Board of Harbor Commissioners. The proposed First Amendment will extend the Agreement by four additional years, for a total of seven years, to February 20, 2024. The total compensation under this Agreement will increase by \$665,346 for a total of \$2,189,375. The proposed First Amendment also modifies the Agreement to reflect updated insurance provisions. The First Amendment is required at this time in order to accommodate delays to the design and implementation schedule for the Wilmington Waterfront Pedestrian Bridge project and to provide continuity of engineering design and engineering support services during construction. Payment of expenses incurred under the Agreement will continue to be the financial responsibility of the Harbor Department. There is no impact to the General Fund.

RECOMMENDATION FOR CITY COUNCIL:

1. ADOPT the determination by the Board of Harbor Commissioners that the proposed action is administratively exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) in accordance with Article II, Section 2(f) of the Los Angeles City CEQA Guidelines;
2. APPROVE Harbor Department Resolution No. 19-9560 authorizing proposed First Amendment Agreement No. 19-3463-A between the City of Los Angeles Harbor Department and T.Y. Lin International; and
3. Return to the Board of Harbor Commissioners for further processing.
