The coronavirus outbreak has caused worldwide concern over the last several weeks. There are currently 11 confirmed cases in the United States, two of them in Los Angeles County. The virus is extremely transmissible and has the potential to spread between people even if the individual is asymptomatic.

Los Angeles World Airport services roughly 63 million passengers annually, and is one of the busiest destination airports in the world. Similarly, the Port of Los Angeles handles more than a third of America's container imports from Pacific Ocean nations. The Port also services cruise lines arriving from and departing to destinations world-wide. Last year, the Port handled about 519,000 passengers via cruise ships.
